History and Function—The Commission was established by the legislature in 1970 to make studies of the needs of the municipal fire services in Oklahoma with particular emphasis on training and education. There are 427 municipal fire departments and 9,100 firefighters in the State. It has authority to establish minimum standards for training courses and to provide certification for the trainees. It also provides training for the municipal fire departments of Oklahoma.

History and Function—The Commission was established by the legislature in 1965. It appoints the State Fire Marshall and adopts rules and regulations consistent with nationally recognized standards of construction and fire safety. The responsibilities of the Agency include investigation of fires of suspicious origin and prosecution of persons guilty of arson; inspection of buildings for public use; examination of plans for building occupancies and enforcement of explosives and fireworks laws. It also has authority for condemnation of structures deemed to be fire hazards.
