OKLAHOMA EMPLOYMENT REPORT - October 2014

Metropolitan statistical area (MSA) and county information

County unemployment rates decline in October

In October, **Latimer County** once again recorded Oklahoma's highest county unemployment rate of 7.4 percent. **Sequoyah County** claimed the second lowest rate, while **McCurtain and McIntosh counties** tied for the third highest county unemployment rate. **Major County** posted the state's lowest county unemployment rate of 2.1 percent. No county unemployment rate increases were reported for October.
