Approximately \$2.45 million will be available to eligible districts through a competitive grant process thanks to Title II, Part B of the No Child Left Behind Act of 2001.

The purpose of the Oklahoma MSP Program is to improve the content knowledge and instructional practices of mathematics and science teachers to increase the achievement of their students. These improvement efforts are to be designed, implemented, and evaluated by strong partnerships
