

Some examples of non-compliance that may be considered as serious are:

- Staff-child ratio
- Supervision of children
- Sleep position; infant sleep environments
- Prohibited disciplinary actions
- Licensed capacity
- Use of passenger restraints
- Water activities
- Pools and other water hazards
- Multiple hazards
- Weapons
- Reporting child abuse
- Knowingly permitting access to children by people identified as restricted or registrants
- Failure to obtain background investigations or child care restricted registry searches
- Administering medication to children
- Room temperatures
- Heat sources and loss of any utility service
- Compliance file and/or posting
- Cardio-pulmonary resuscitation and first aid training
- Liability insurance and vehicle liability insurance
